Installation Guide

VOTRONIC Energy Monitor APK-File



The VOTRONIC Energy Monitor App is currently being revised to meet the requirements of the current and future Android versions. The VOTRONIC Energy Monitor App is therefore currently not available for Android versions 12 and higher via the Google Play Store.

For **Android versions 11** and older, the VOTRONIC Energy Monitor App is still available as usual in the Google Play Store and can be downloaded and installed.

For Android smartphones with **Android version 12 and 13**, we offer the option of manually downloading and installing the VOTRONIC Energy Monitor App as an APK-File. The current VOTRONIC Energy Monitor App continues to work with Android versions 12 and 13 and is easy to install.

Instructions to install the APK-File manually

Before you can manually install the APK files on your Android device, you need to configure some installation settings, which you can reset after the successful installation:

- 1. Open "Settings" on your device.
- 2. Select "Security" "Device Management" and enable the feature "Unknown Sources".
 - a. Depending on the device, you will find the setting for unknown sources under "Apps" "Special app access" "Install unknown apps" Enable your mobile browsers (e.g. Chrome) or
 - b. under "Biometrics and security" "Install unknown apps".
- 3. Now you are able to install apps (APK-Files) that are not from the Play Store. After the successful installation, you can deactivate this option.

After changing this setting, you can proceed with the installation:

1. First you need to do is download the APK-File to your device. The easiest way is to download the APK-File directly to the smartphone via the mobile browser. You may need to acknowledge a notice at the bottom of the screen warning of potential download hazards.

Alternatively, you can transfer the APK-File from your computer to your mobile device using a USB cable.

- 2. Now start the APK-File by tapping on it (notification bar message about the successful download). The downloaded file can also be found under "Downloads".
- 3. Now all you have to do is confirm the installation ("Install"). The app will then be installed.
